NOTE:Info from Pam Spooner at: wspoone@san.rr.com says came to Davis, IA with parents about 1850. Migrated to Oklahoma. "My Aunt Lois (Henderson)Clement [my mother, Jewel's sister: descendant of William Jasper's sister Mary Emily Lawson Henderson] told me that, according to family records, William Jasper was a Civil War (Union) veteran and that he made it through the whole ordeal without a scratch.' His brother, John H. Lawson, was also a Union soldier and, according to my grandfather (Charlie Johnston Henderson), he was shot in the chest/lungs during the Civil War and, after recovering from his wounds, he received a rifle ball crease in his scalp. After the war, John Lawson, returned to the family farm and worked it with his mother, Rachel Russell Lawson, who was the head-of-household. (That was after his father's disappearance) I don't believe John ever married. He is buried beside his mother in Davis Co, IA. My grandfather said he (John) was very smart and well read. I know the unit in which John served and assume that perhaps William Jasper was in the same company. I sent away for Williams's Civil War pension records but not received yet. I will request John's too."

Death certificate states cause of death was senility, nephritis and pulmonary edema. Attending physician was W. B. Newell, MD, of Hunter, OK. He attended from 9 Feb to 12 Feb 1915. Undertaker was Ed Groom of Hunter. Informant was Mrs. S. A. Beck of Hunter per W. B. Newell (attending MD). Occupation: farmer. Had lived at current residence 1 month and 7 days.
Former address was Missouri.

Melissa Ellen Scott, 76, died at her home in Covington early Saturday morning following an illness of five weeks.

She was born in Iowa but moved to Missouri with her parents at an early age. In 1887 she married A. Owen Scott at Butler, MO.

Mrs. Scott was a member of the Methodist church until coming to Oklahoma in 1906. Later she joined the Christian Union Church at Pleasant Valley near Douglas.

She had lived on a farm near Douglas since 1906 until her husband's retirement when they moved to Covington about 13 years ago. In Covington, she joined the First Christian Church.

Survivors include her husband, A. Owen Scott, of the home; four daughters, Mrs. Bertha Coleman of Hutchinson, Kans, Mrs. Alma Stout of Douglas, Mrs. Fannie Gowin of Bartlesville, and Mrs. Rachel Rhodes of Roswell, NM; four sons, Ernest of Covington, Delmar of Douglas, Ivan of Salt Lake City, Urah, and Owen of Washington, D.C.; two sisters Mrs. Effie Lewis of Sedalia, MO and Mrs. Belle Wilcox of Los Angeles, Calif; twenty grandchildren and twelve great grandchildren.
