The first cemetery (Texhoma's First <<http://www.rootsweb.com/~okcemete/texas/texhoma/texhoma.htm>>) in the Texhoma area was 1 miles East and ½ North on the state line road, on the A.N. Edmonds land, now owned by the State of Oklahoma. Mr. Jesse Brown Riffe donated land for a new, larger cemetery which opened in January 1908, with Section 1 and through the years additional sections were opened. Some of the interments from the first cemetery were moved to the new one, but not all.
