The funeral for Mrs. Harvey (Alma) Stout, 88, will be at 2 p.m. Wednesday in the Henniger-Allen Funeral Home Chapel with Dr. Richard Duckworth and the Rev. H. I. Jones officiating. Burial will be in the Cherokee Municipal Cemetery at Cherokee.

The casket will be open until service time and will remain closed afterward.

Mrs. Stout died early Monday in a local nursing home. She was born Aug. 22, 1895, at Rich Hill, MO and came to Oklahoma with her parents in 1906.

She and Harvey M. Stout were married Dec. 25, 1913. They established their home near Douglas where they farmed. They also owned and operated a cafe in the Douglas area for several years.

Mrs. Stout was preceded in death by her husband on March 28, 1972, and by a daughter, two infant granddaughters, three brothers and three sisters.
